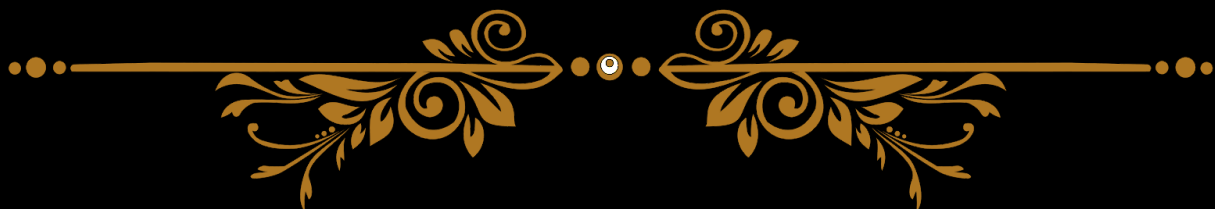

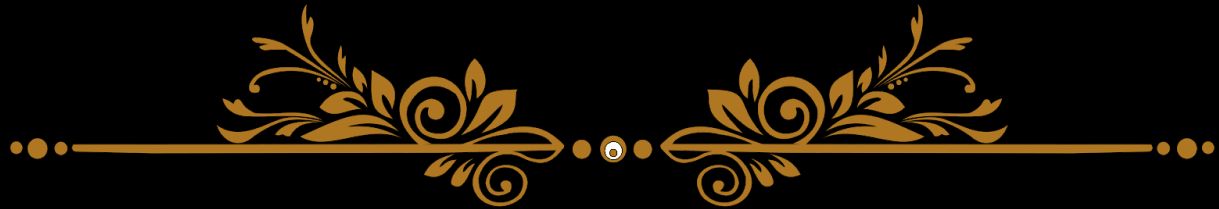

Editorial Note

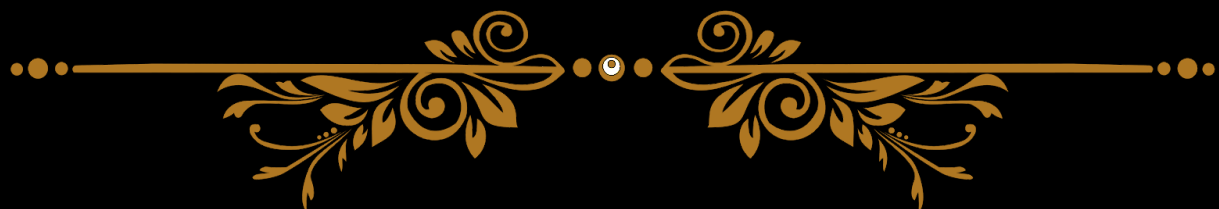
